- Nebraska has scored on their first drive in four of the last five games this year.
- There has been at least one non-offensive score in the last 9 matchups between these two schools. NU does not have an unconventional score yet this season.
- Last week's game vs Oklahoma State was the first game since the 2003 Big 12 Championship game that Kansas State did not commit a turnover.

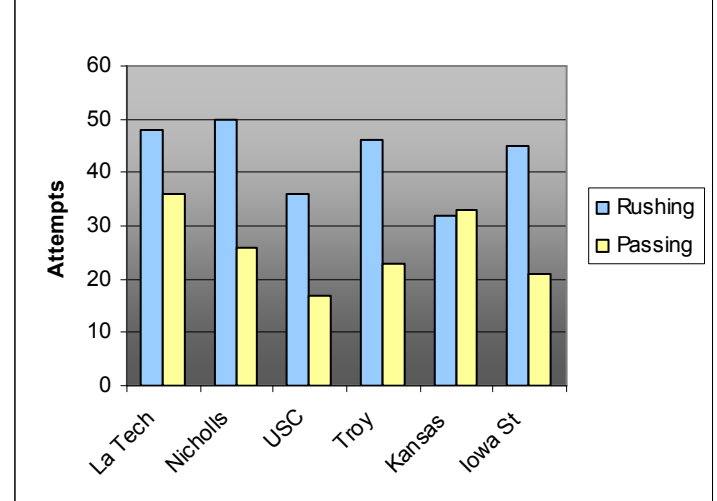

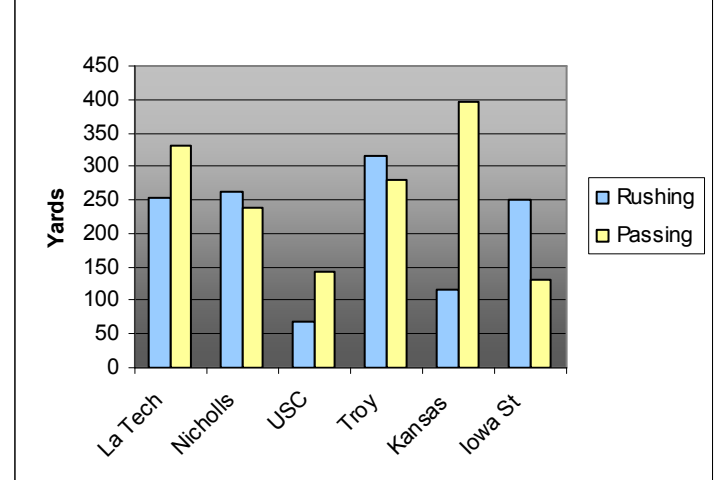
